The Middlesex County Mosquito Extermination Commission is pleased to announce the addition of a newly acquired mosquito control helicopter.

BELL JETRANGER 206 BIII, (REG # N206DP), Red & White Color

Residents may call/report/ask about our new low-flying Jet Ranger helicopter over parts of Middlesex County.

The red and white JetRanger helicopter (enclosed picture) is part of the Commission's aerial treatment program to control mosquitoes. It will be used along with the previous Green/Yellow Hiller helicopter (UH-12E, Reg # N48123).

The Commission helicopters can be expected to fly at low speeds and about 100-feet above the ground over large mosquito habitats in non-residential areas of the County. The aerial surveillance and control of mosquitoes using helicopters will occur from April 1, 2018 through November 30, 2018.
