



# Borough of South Plainfield Hometown Heroes Program Application



The Borough of South Plainfield, in partnership with American Legion Chaumont Post 243, Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW) Post 6763 and Elks Lodge 2298 recently honored the South Plainfield veterans killed in action. Banners honoring the fallen have been displayed on the lampposts along Plainfield Ave in front of Boro Hall.

We are expanding the program (Phase II) to honor all South Plainfield veterans. **The deadline to submit applications is February 28, 2020.**

## Eligibility Requirements

An individual is eligible to participate if they have served in any one of the following branches of the United States Armed Forces:

- Air Force
- Army
- Marines
- Navy
- Coast Guard
- Merchant Marines (World War II)
- Women Air Force Service Pilots (World War II)

Applicants must also meet the following criteria:

- Are retired, honorably discharged or killed in action (deceased individuals may be honored by their family)
- Have lived in South Plainfield at any time in the past or present

**In 2020, the program will be expanded to include an additional 100 applicants that meet the eligibility requirements.**

Banners will be displayed from Memorial Day thru Veteran's Day on the lampposts in the center of town and along Hamilton Blvd. The cost to sponsor a South Plainfield Veteran is \$85. Included in your donation, sponsors will receive an 8x10 framed paper print of their banner. Additional framed prints available at an extra cost of \$20 each.
