MAYOR'S WELLNESS CAMPAIGN COMMITTEE

The Wellness Campaign Committee shall be responsible for the development, plan, organization and execution of programs designed to help the Borough attain and maintain the Healthy Town designation from the State of New Jersey. They shall lend their advice to the Mayor, Borough Administrator, Borough Clerk and Borough Council on all matters dealing with the Healthy Town designation. They may employ individuals or organize support groups of volunteers with the authorization and consent of the Governing Body to assist the Borough in maintaining the Healthy Town designation.

The Wellness Campaign Committee shall consist of four members. Each member shall be appointed by the Mayor with the advice and consent of the Borough Council.

- a. The Committee shall consist of the following members:
 - (1) One member shall be assigned to develop, plan, organize and execute programs for the youth of the Borough;
 - (2) One member shall be assigned to develop, plan, organize and execute programs for the employers of the Borough;
 - (3) One member shall be assigned to develop, plan, organize and execute programs for the seniors of the Borough;
 - (4) One member shall be assigned to develop, plan, organize and execute programs for the benefit of the community at large; and
 - (5) Two at-large members assigned to develop, plan, organize and execute programs to the benefit of the community at large.
- b. Each member shall be appointed for a four-year term, with the exception that initial appointments shall be for one-year appointments for two members; two-year appointments for two members; and, three and four-year terms for two members so that one or two positions on the Committee shall terminate each year. It shall be in the discretion of the Mayor with the advice and consent of the Council as to which member is initially appointed to the aforesaid terms.
- c. All members of the Wellness Campaign Committee shall serve without compensation.
