Borough Attorney Paul Rizzo - reported progress.

<u>Administrator Cullen</u> – advised that the work zone around the pool has expanded to accommodate deliveries and the baby pool is new being worked on. <u>Councilman White</u> – thanked the Council for the proclamation this evening and went on to say that the Portuguese BBQ by Cicio's Pizza will be having their grand opening this week and Aldi's and LA Fitness are still moving along.

<u>Councilwoman Mott</u> – thanked Mr. Miller for always being so responsive. He recently took care of some pothole requests by some residents. There now are some dead tree limbs that need to be tended to. Mr. Miller said he put in a request to PSE&G for that.

Councilman Bengivenga - reported progress.

<u>Council President Faustini</u> – advised that on behalf of Cultural Arts the photo of the month theme last month was Winter. The picture will be hung at Borough Hall. February's there will be Up Close and Personal in South Plainfield. Buddy Ball Basketball began last night, and anyone interested can still sign-up. The Friends of the Library is sponsoring a night out on March 26^{th} and to conclude, the auditions for the talent show will be this Saturday and again on March 1^{st} .

Roberto Sayers of West Crescent asked for clarification of resolution 20-90 specifically what the funds will be used for. Councilman Bengivenga explained that they will be used for improvements to Pitt Street Park and the Senior Director Salary.

Councilman Bengivenga explained it can be used for census blocks, ADA compliance, park improvements etc. Mr. Dean asked if we are going to do anything with Conch Park. Mr. Miller said yes DPW will get back there. Mr. Dean asked pertaining to resolution 20-93 if the money will take care of everything, including the parking lot. Mr. Cullen explained what the money will be applied to. Mr. Dean said he was concerned with the sanitary lines. Mr. Dean asked if the architect is under estimating. Mr. Cullen said yes it appears so. Mr. Dean asked how the parking lot will be handled. Councilman Bengivenga said there should be enough money left over for the pool parking lot, but our main focus at the moment is the pool and having it open on time. Mr. Dean asked if the concrete was shot at the pool yet. Mr. Cullen said no, it will probably be done sometime in March.

Nancy Grennier reminded the Council of Career Day next Wednesday and said she looks forward to seeing everyone there.

Without further comment and no more action necessary for this evening Mayor Anesh called for a motion to adjourn. Councilman White made a motion to adjourn at 7:58 p.m., seconded by Councilman Bengivenga and unanimously carried. The meeting was adjourned.
